Time is what it's all about in "Flipping the Apocalypse," which features drama, dance, music, poetry and video art by Carport Theater veterans and new faces and voices. The show starts with the line "We are 90 seconds from doomsday." From the perspective of linear time it points to an inescapable catastrophe. But could this be just an apocalyptic myth created by the human mind, attempting to understand timelessness within the world of time? To contemplate this, just like facing one's own individual death, can collapse ego structures and open the door to love.

In presenting it to the public, the hope is that both performers and audience members will be able to feel a shift in perspective, a loosening of the experience of linear time, opening to new realms of imagination from which unexpected answers can come.

This will be the 12th annual Community Performance for the Carport Theater, and its return to downtown for a one-night only show at the Sea of Glass Center for the Arts.
